Impressive recognition

Delivered in Milan in memory of Rino Zandonai . Received by the President of the Trentini nel Mondo, Alberto Tofner, from the President of the Lombardy Region, Roberto Formigoni, the award to Rino Zandonai was granted under the 2011 Peace Prize of the Regione Lombardia.

Also present were Rino's sister, Annamaria Zandonai, and a representative of the Trentini nel Mondo

Rino Zandonai was director for nearly twenty years of Trentini nel Mondo. Rino was one of the ten Italian victims when Air France Flight 447 crashed into the Atlantic Ocean. Rino is described as an educator, supporter of peace and dialogue. During the civil war in former Yugoslavia Rino brought basic necessities and medicine to the Bosnian community. "Rino Zandonai believed in the power of constructive dialogue and love to others as a condition of true peace and helped to address the cooperative model in other communities marred by war" said President of the Lombardy Region, Roberto Formigoni.

Almost two months from the date of the crash and 228 deaths, 50 corpses have surfaced, including that of Rino. News and identification were provided by the French foreign ministry to the families and Zandonai's Trentini nel Mondo

No one knows exactly what happened. A couple of months ago at the end of the long investigation it was determined that the crash was caused by "human error." More than three years have passed since that June 1, 2009 but the Trentini communities around the world still miss Rino who was a pillar on which everyone could rely on for more than just emigration.
