

#### Temporary return in Trentino

The Servizio Emigrazione e Solidarieta'
Internazionale della Provincia Autonoma di
Trento announces that from January 1 to March 31
2013 applications are being accepted for the
reimbursement of travel expenses for the
temporary return to Trentino for those aged over
60.

The Province supports the temporary return of senior emigrants to Trentino. The intention is to meet one of the strongest desires of our emigrants: revisit – sometimes after decades - their land of origin.

For the immigrant who does not have accommodations in Trentino, there is the possibility of reimbursement of travel and accommodation for a maximum of 80 euro per day for a maximum of 15 days. Eligibility can include a companion in cases of necessity as evidenced by a medical certificate.

Eligibility is for those who originated from Trentino or were residents in a municipality of Trentino for more than ten years before the date of emigration. The immigrant must also be at least 60 years of age and have never returned to Trentino in the last 15 years with the financial support of the Province.


